Today's modern YCAT bus fleet has many design features that make riding easy for seniors, including:

- Low Floors - No Steps to Climb
- "Kneeling" Feature Lowers Bus to Ground Level
- Flip-Out Ramp for Wheelchairs, Walkers
- Drivers Announce Major & Requested Stops
- Two Wheelchair Locations on Every Bus
