EMPLOYEES AND VOLUNTEERS OF YUMA REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER CAN RIDE YCAT BUSES FREE STARTING MARCH 1!

YUMA, AZ (February 28, 2013) - Yuma County Intergovernmental Public Transportation Authority (YCIPTA) and Yuma Regional Medical Center (YRMC) has entered into a new partnership to where all employees and volunteers from YRMC can now all YCAT routes free of charge unrestricted.

As part of the memorandum of understanding, YRMC will also receive 500 YCAT DayPasses that will be distributed to Hospital guests that may need transportation home after visiting YRMC.

YRMC employees and volunteers may obtain a sticker from the Human Resources Office located at 399 32nd Street, Yuma in the Yuma Regional Medical Corporate Center. All YRMC facilities are accessible via various YCAT routes. Information can be obtained online or by calling YCAT.

This pilot program is available from March 1, 2013 to September 30, 2013. YCIPTA will survey and track employee and volunteer usage. It is hopeful that the program will continue beyond on the pilot period, however, it is based off employee usage.
