Yuma County Area Transit (YCAT) provides fixed route bus, vanpool and complementary paratransit service throughout southwestern Yuma County and eastern Imperial County. YCAT's service area includes: • Yuma • San Luis • Somerton • Wellton • Cocopah and Fort Yuma Indian Reservations • Winterhaven • El Centro • Gadsden • Tacna • Ligurta • Fortuna Foothills.

Service Hours

- Monday-Friday: 5:50 AM to 7:30 PM, with limited evening service until 11:30 PM
- Saturday: 9:00 AM. to 6:30 PM
- Sunday: No service

Holidays

No service is provided on New Years Day, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Presidents Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Saturday schedule operates on Christmas Eve, New Years Eve and the day after Thanksgiving.

How to Use This Guide

This guide provides everything you need to know to ride YCAT's bus routes. Here's how to use it.

1. Use the downtown Yuma route map (Page 22) and the systemwide map (found in the centerfold of the guide) to identify the route or routes that connect the places you wish to travel between.

2. Use the table of contents on the cover to find the page for your route(s). For each route, the guide includes a detailed route map and a timetable for each direction of travel.
3. The individual route maps will show major destinations and timepoints along the route. The locations where transfers can be made will also be shown on the route map.
4. The timetables shows when the bus serves major stops along the route (timepoints). The timepoints are shown across the top of the timetable. Select the timetable for your direction of travel. Then read down from the timepoint where you will be boarding to see what times the bus will serve that stop. Then read to the right to see when it will reach your destination stop.
5. The bus also serves many other stops in between the timepoints. Use the timepoint before your stop to estimate the time the bus will reach your stop and then be at the stop 5 minutes early as travel times may vary.
6. Please note that not all trips operate on Saturday. The timetable will indicate which trips run on Saturday.

Cómo usar esta guía

Esta guía incluye todo lo que necesita saber para viajar por las rutas de autobús de YCAT. Aquí le indicamos cómo usar el servicio.

1. Con el mapa de rutas del centro de Yuma (página 22) y el mapa de todo el sistema (que se encuentra en el centro de esta guía), identifique la ruta o las rutas que conectan los lugares entre los que quiere viajar.
2. En el índice de la portada, ubique la página correspondiente a sus rutas. Esta guía ofrece un mapa de ruta detallado para cada ruta y un horario para cada dirección de viaje.

3. Los mapas de rutas individuales muestran los principales destinos y horarios a lo largo de la ruta. En el mapa de rutas también se indicarán los lugares donde se pueden efectuar trasbordos.
4. Los horarios indican a qué hora pasa el autobús por las principales paradas a lo largo de la ruta, las cuales aparecen en la parte superior del horario. Seleccione el horario correspondiente a su dirección de viaje. Luego lea a partir de la parada en la que quiere abordar el autobús para ver a qué horas pasará el autobús por esa parada. Luego lea hacia la derecha para ver cuándo llegará a su parada de destino.
5. El autobús también pasa por muchas otras paradas entre las paradas principales indicadas. Use la parada anterior a la suya para calcular el tiempo en que el autobús llegará a su parada y esté ahí 5 minutos antes porque los tiempos del viaje pueden variar.
6. Tenga presente que no todos los recorridos funcionan los sábados. El horario indicará qué recorridos funcionan los sábados.

YCATPass can be purchased online, by mail, by fax or at YCAT's office. There is a \$2.00 fee for the initial card and a \$5.00 replacement fee if lost.

- Children under 9 must be accompanied by a fare paying passenger 16 years or older in order to ride YCAT.

Free Rides

Children under 5 ride free. Up to four children per adult. Additional children pay discount fare.

The following groups ride fare-free with proper ID:

- Cocopah Tribal members with tribal ID card. (Tribal member guests must pay the appropriate fare.)
- Students, employees, and/or faculty from Arizona Western College (AWC), Northern Arizona University (NAU), University of Arizona (UA), Yuma Private Industry Council Charter High School, Aztec High School, and Vista High School with current YCAT sticker.

Notas sobre las tarifas

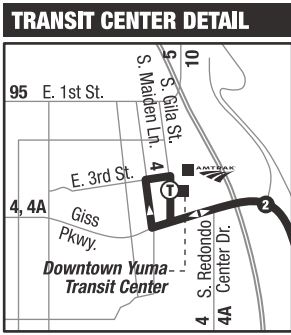
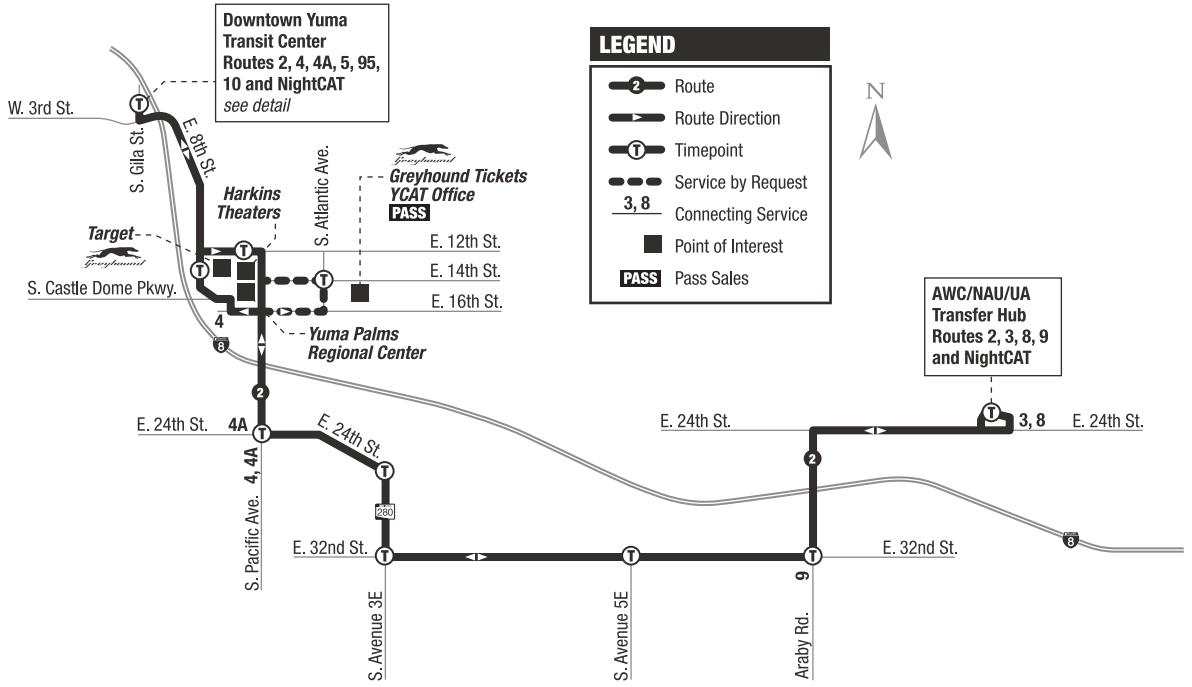

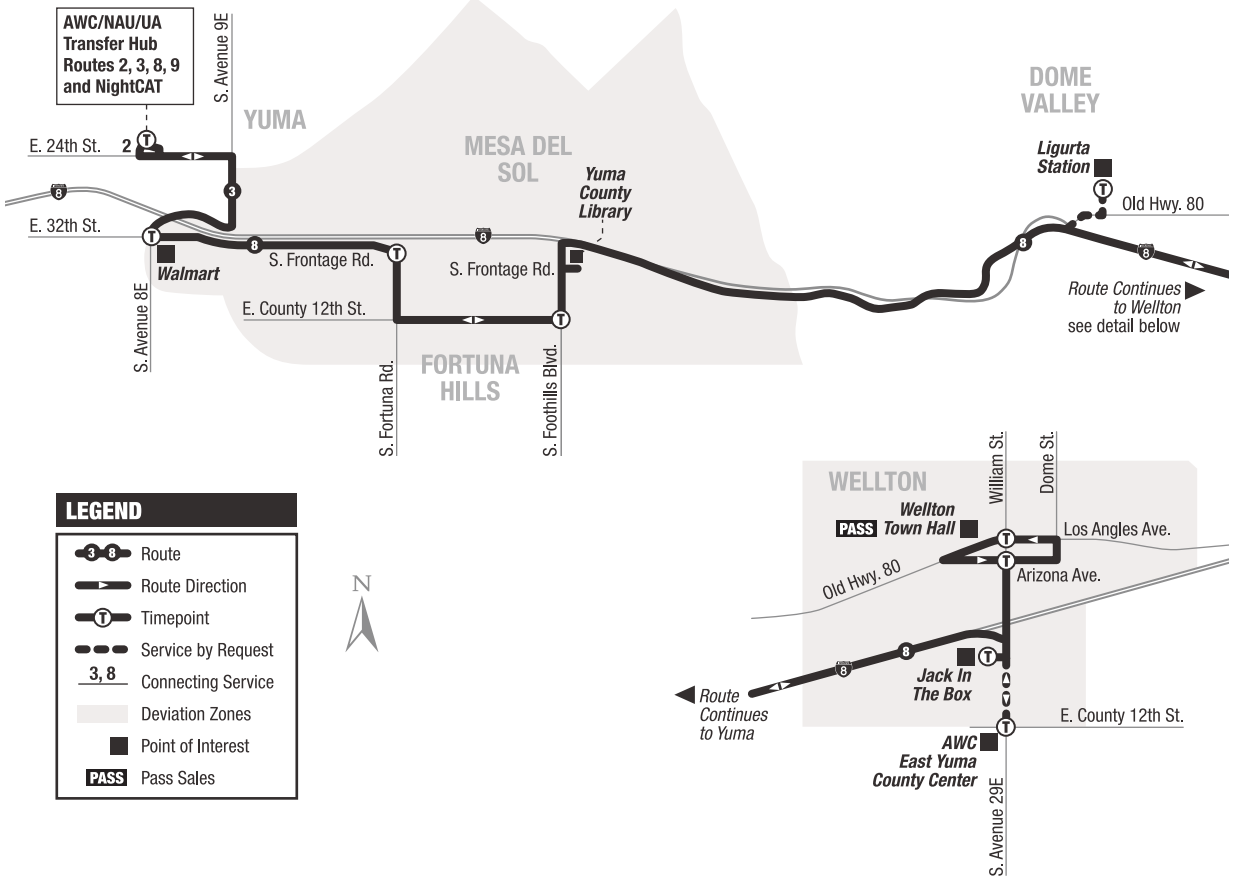

Flexible Service

Brown Route 3 provides flexible mini-bus service throughout most of Fortuna Foothills and Mesa Del Sol. The bus will take you anywhere in the route zone shown on the map or to a timed transfer with Orange Route 2 at AWC/NAU/UA.

- You can catch the bus at the timepoints shown on the schedule for the regular fare.
- You can be picked up at your door by calling (928) 783-2235 at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trip. (Reservations can be made up to 24 hours in advance.) There is an additional \$2.00 fee for being picked up at your door.
- Please note that the vehicle may arrive up to 5 minutes before or after your scheduled pick-up time.
- For reserved pickups: Latest allowable reservation is **5:20 PM** on weekdays.
Latest allowable reservation is **1:50 PM** on Saturdays.

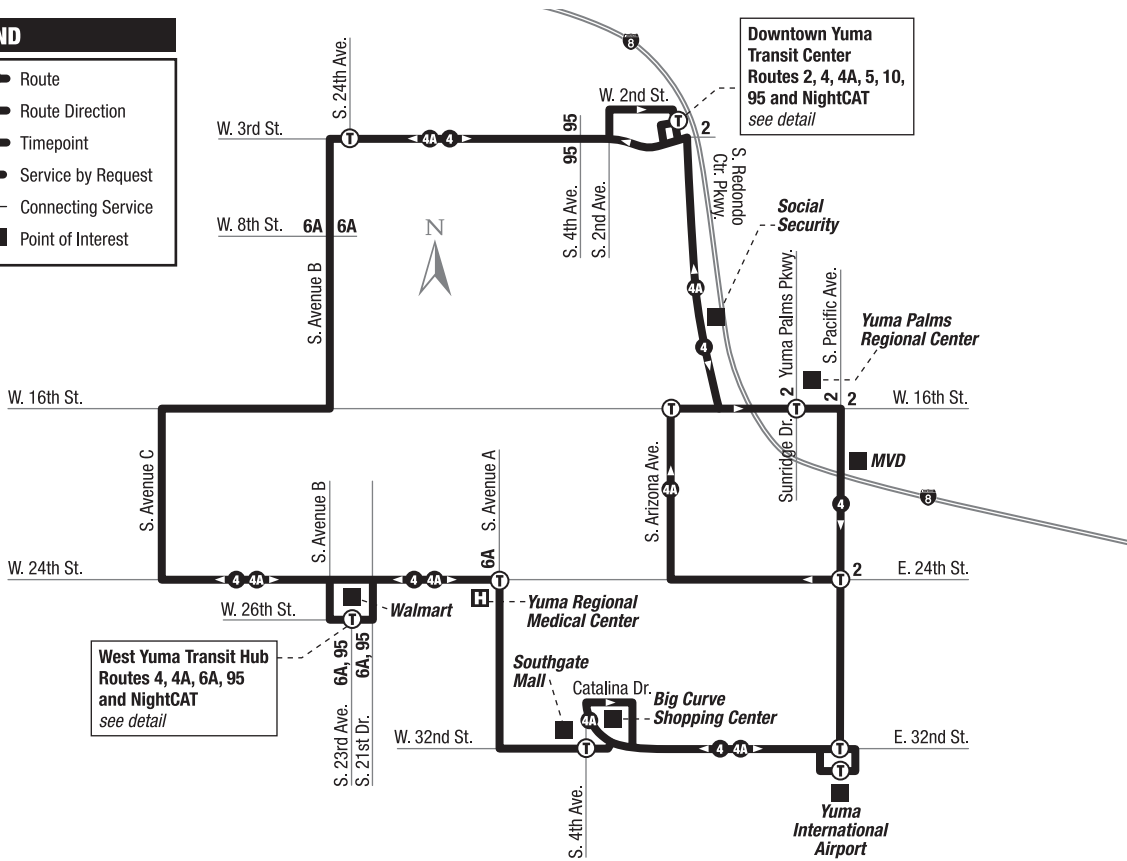
Gold Route 8 can flex off route to pick up or drop off passengers up to 1-1/2 mile on either side of the route. Passengers may request the bus to flex off route by asking the Bus Operator or calling (928) 783-2235 at least 60 minutes in advance. Requests for flex stops are limited to the first four (4) requests per one-way trip. There is an additional fare of \$2.00 for all passengers who request a flex.

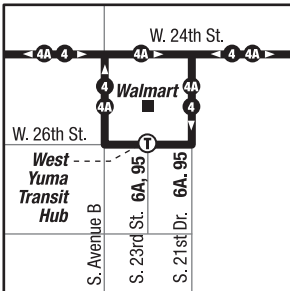

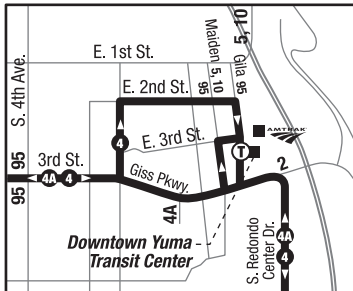

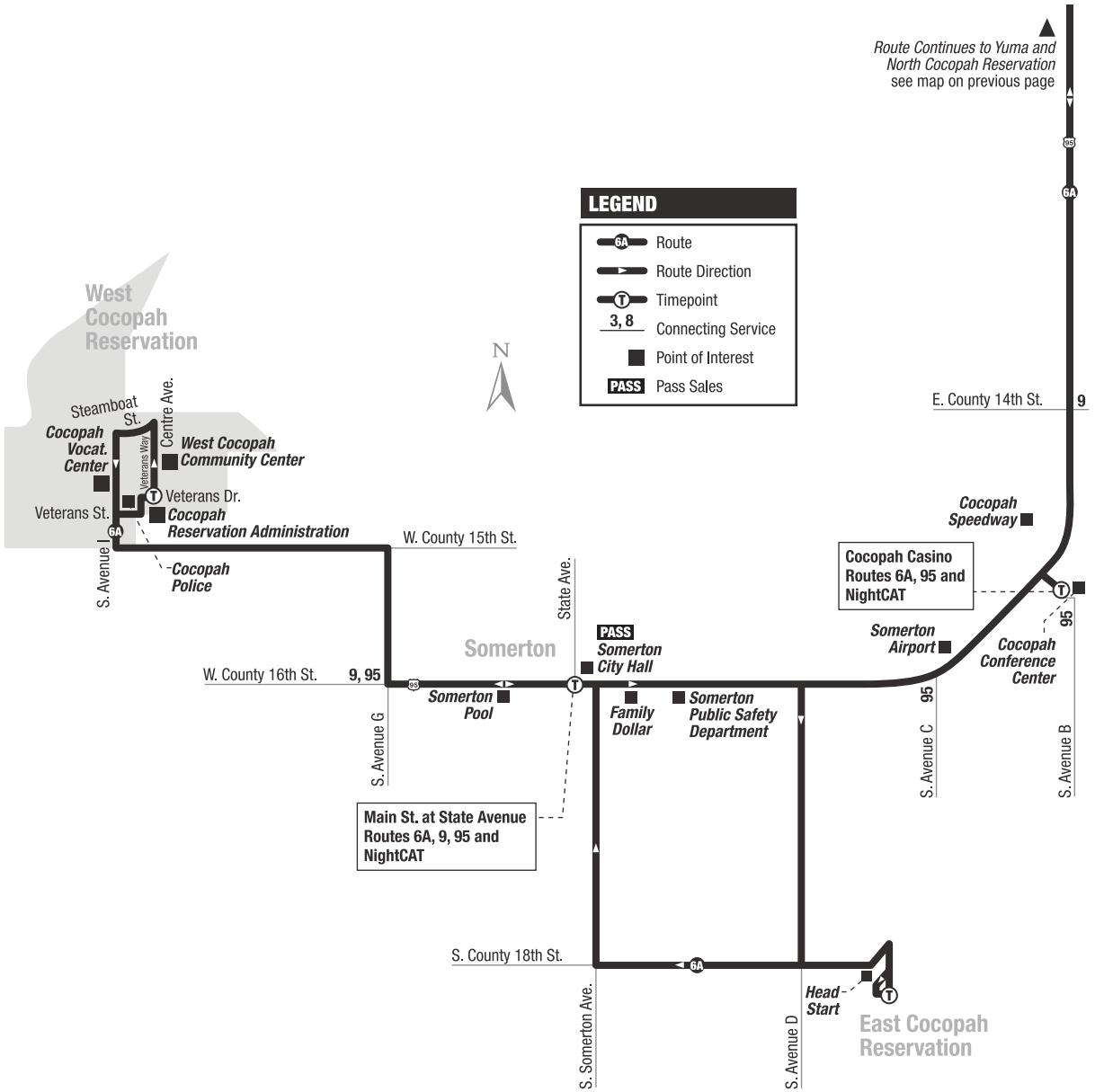

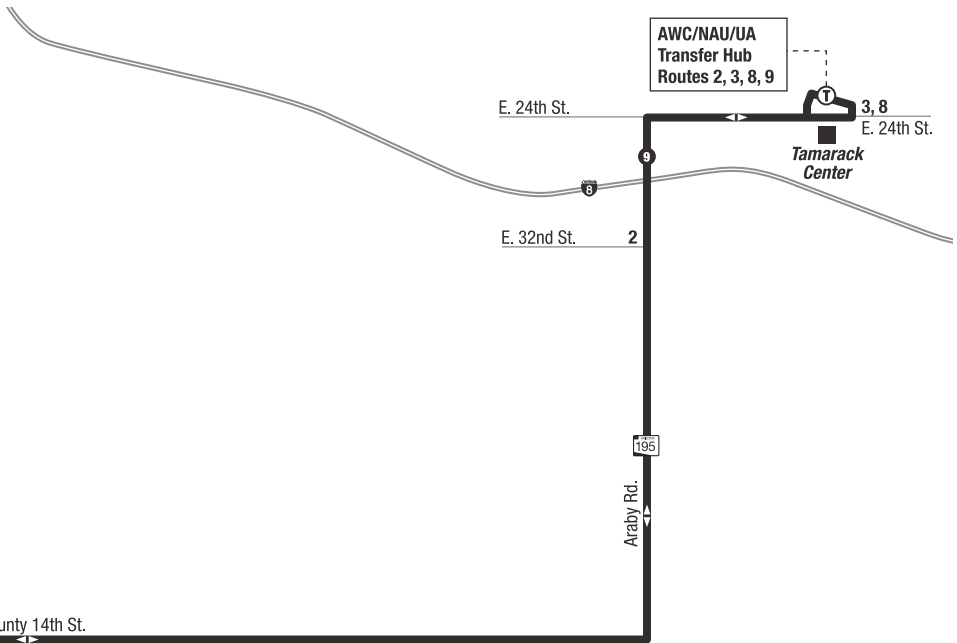
Silver Route 9 – South County AWC Connector – Route Map

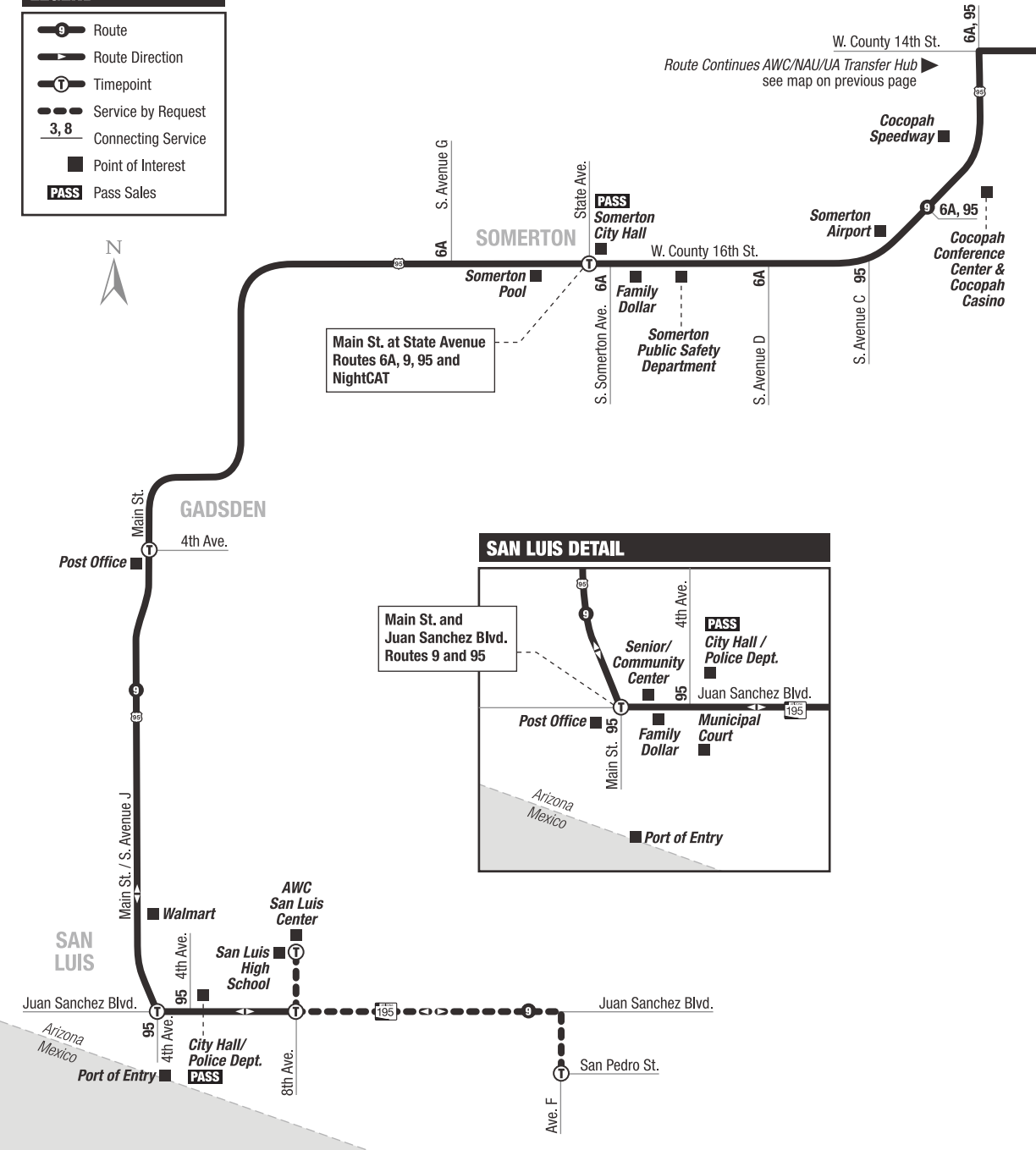

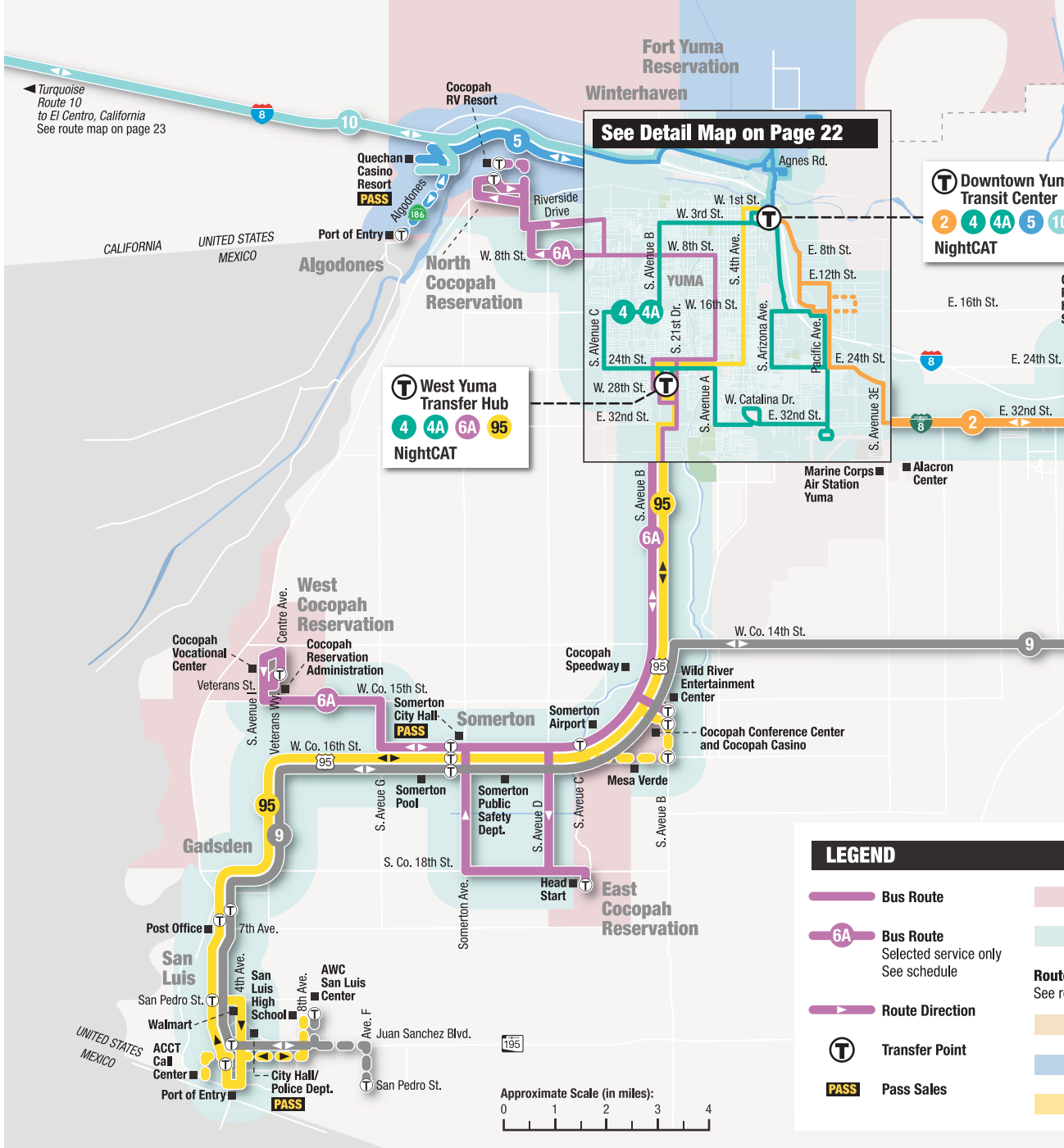

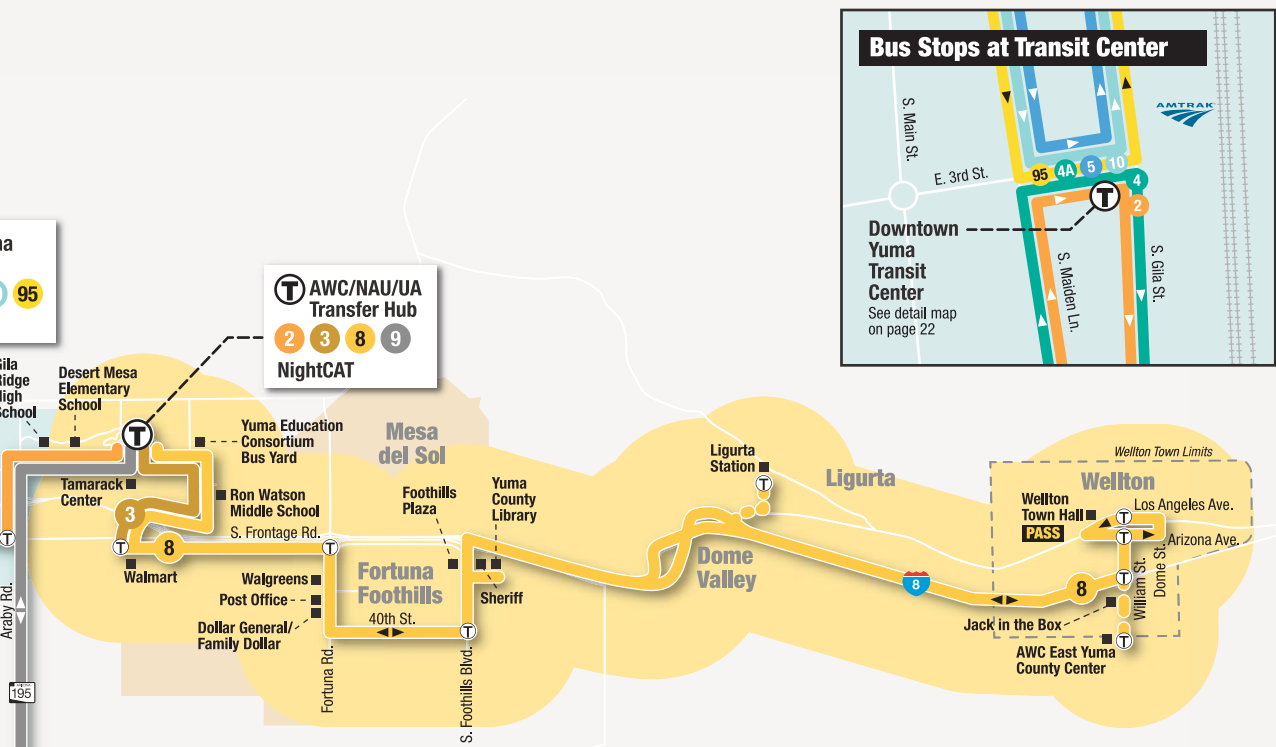


SAN LUIS DETAIL

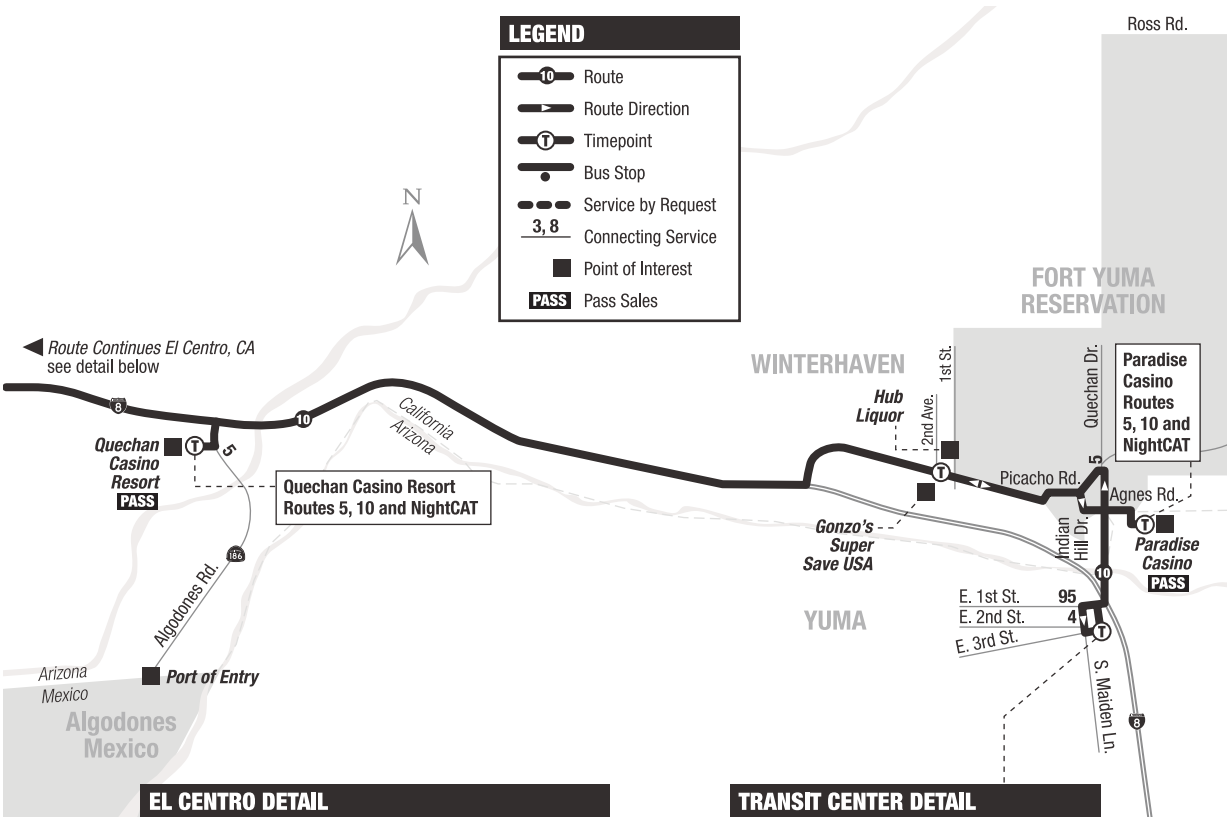

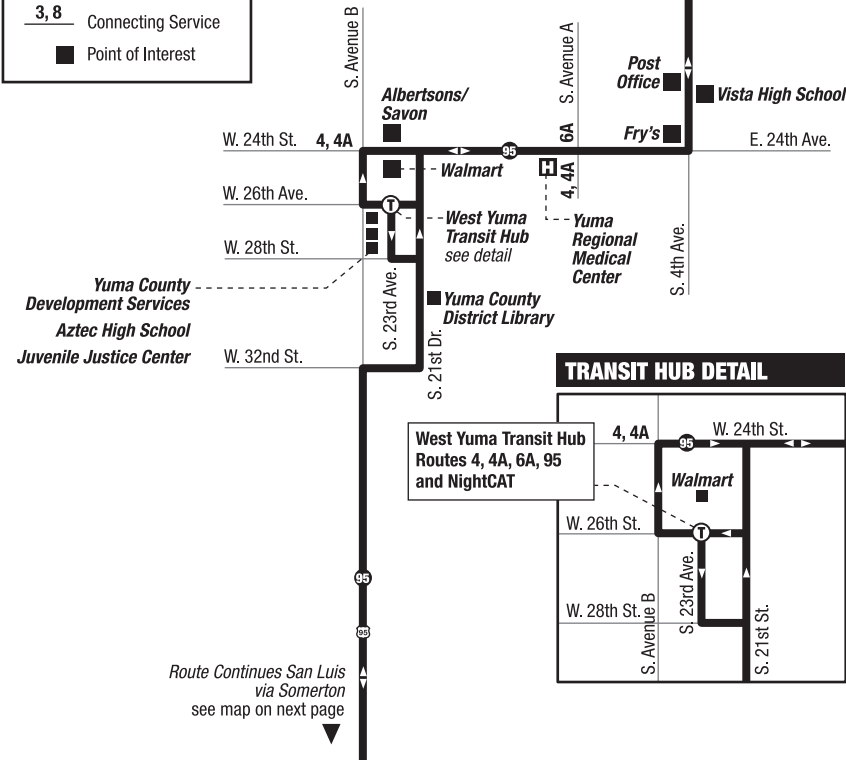

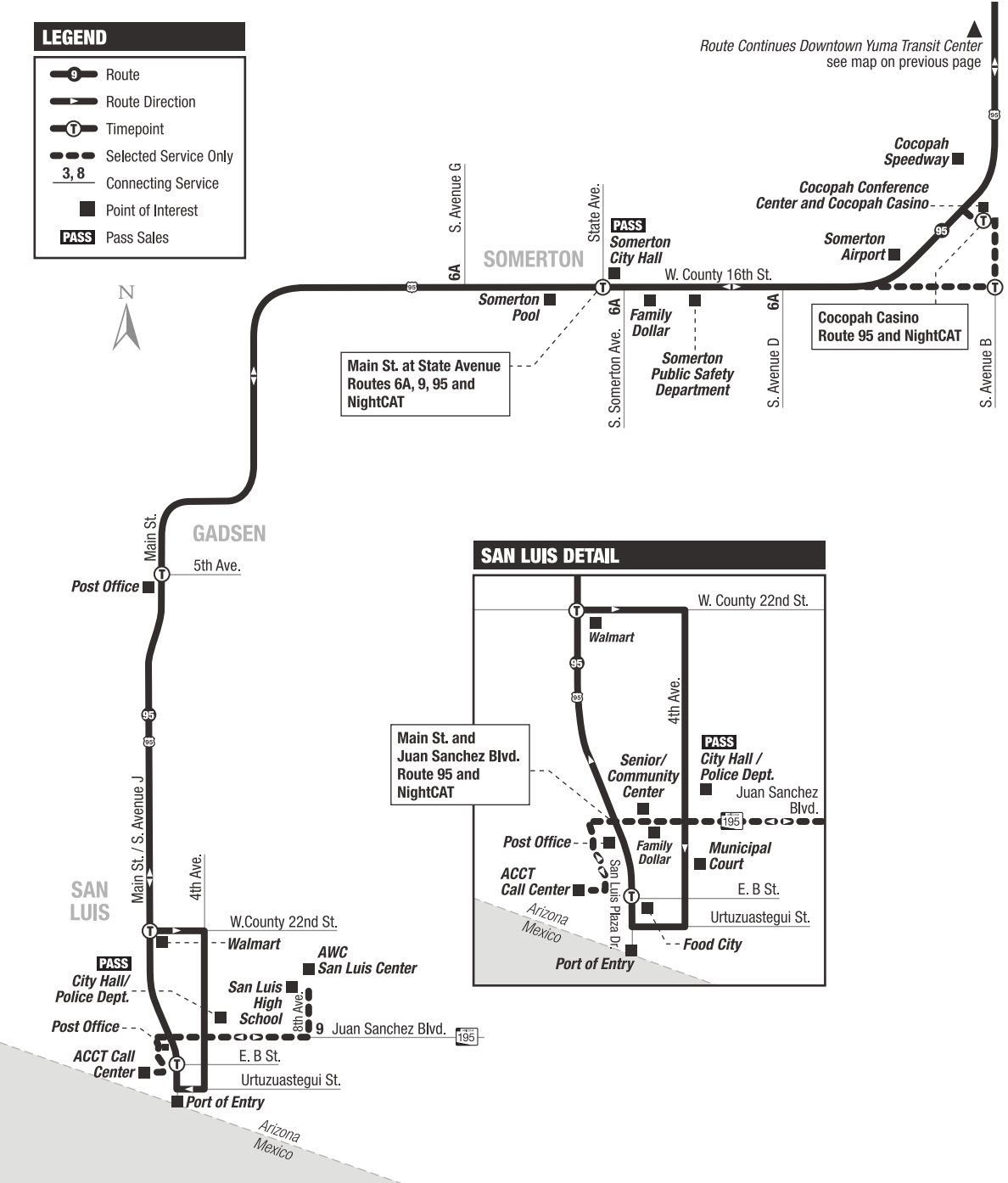

How to Ride YCAT

Bus Stops: YCAT buses only stop at signed bus stops. Flag stops are not permitted. A complete bus stop list for each route is available on our website at www.ycat.az.gov or pick up a bus stop Guide on the bus.



Catching the Bus: Be at the bus 5 minutes before the scheduled departure. Make sure the driver can see you. Check the headsign on the front of the bus to insure you board the correct route.

Paying your Fare: Be ready to pay your fare or present your pass when you board. Exact fare only. Bus Operators cannot make change.

Exiting the Bus: When you see your destination or transfer point, signal the bus operator, by pulling the cord near the window, pushing the yellow strip or calling out “next stop”. Please provide enough notice, so that the bus operator can stop safely. If you are not familiar with the area, ask the bus operator for assistance.

Flex Route Deviations: On some routes you can request to be picked up or dropped off at locations between regularly schedule bus stops. Deviations are available:

- Anywhere along Brown Route 3 within the Fortuna Foothills.
- Blue Route 5 within the Fort Yuma Indian Reservation and within 3/4 mile radius of the actual route.
- Purple Route 6A within the Cocopah Indian Reservations.
- Gold Route 8 within 1-1/2 mile radius of the actual route.

For deviated drop off, just ask your bus operator. To be picked up, call (928) 783-2235, at least one hour prior to the bus coming by your location to request a deviation. Deviations are limited to the first four (4) requests per one way trip. Please call ahead to cancel if the deviation is no longer needed to allow another person the opportunity to ride.

Night Owl: At night, upon request, the bus operator can stop at a location that is closer to your final destination rather than the regular stop. The bus operator will determine where it is safe to pull over.

Bicycles: Bicycle racks are located on the front of all YCAT buses. Racks are available on a first come-first served basis. Riders are responsible for loading and unloading bicycles, and use the racks at their own risk. Please let the driver know when you need to load or unload a bike.



Animals on YCAT: Service animals are welcome. Non-service animals may travel on the bus if secured in a cage or muzzle.

Lost and Found: If you leave an item on a YCAT vehicle, please call (928) 783-2235 to see if it has been retrieved. YCIPTA or its contractors are not responsible for lost or stolen items on board its vehicles.

Mobility Training: New to transit? Learn how to ride YCAT and plan your trip. Upon completion of the training, you will receive a free 10-Ride YCATPass. Call (928) 539-7076 or e-mail info@ycipta.az.gov for more information.

YCATPasses

YCATPasses utilize a smart card technology which allows you to store money and passes on a reusable card. YCATPasses can store e-cash up to \$300. When you use e-cash to pay your fare or buy a Day YCATPass, you received a discount. The initial cost of the YCATPass is \$2.00. Replacement of a lost YCATPass is \$5.00.

Special Services for Persons with Disabilities and Seniors

YCAT OnCall Demand Response Service

This door to door demand responsive bus service is available to persons with disabilities unable to board YCAT buses or access a bus stop. In order to use YCAT OnCall, passengers must complete an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Certification Application. YCAT OnCall operates the same service hours as YCAT non-express fixed route service. Passengers must board, travel and alight within 3/4 mile of an operating YCAT route. Please see the system map for the YCAT OnCall service boundary. For more information about YCAT OnCall, including trip reservations, cancellations and certification, call, visit our website or see the YCAT OnCall Information Guide.

Accessibility

All YCAT vehicles are fully equipped with mobility device lifts and a mobility device securement area with space for two to four mobility devices. The bus operator will provide assistance with normal boarding or exiting, mobility device securement and operation of the lift/ramp. YCAT bus operators are required to secure all mobility devices before the bus can leave the bus stop.



Passengers using a scooter may be asked to transfer to a seat on the bus. All mobility aids must be able to fit within the allocated space, have working brakes and cannot exceed the capacity of the lift/ramp (with the passenger and mobility aid). If the mobility aid cannot fit the lift/ramp platform, the passenger will not be able to ride. Mobility devices with leaking batteries or fluids will not be allowed to board.

If a YCAT bus without a working wheelchair lift arrives at your bus stop, YCAT will send a road supervisor or YCAT OnCall bus within 30 minutes to take the passenger directly to their destination free of charge.

Personal Care Attendants

A PCA can accompany a person with a disability at no additional charge. If you need a PCA, call (928) 783-2235 one day in advance. The rate is \$10.00 per hour.

Other YCAT Services

YCAT Vanpool

Vanpooling is a great option for larger groups of commuters. YCAT Vanpool provides clearly marked vans to qualifying groups of 7-15 commuters, driven by one of the vanpool members. Passengers share the cost of operating the van by paying a monthly fee to the primary driver. The fee covers gas, insurance, and vehicle maintenance costs. YCIPTA provides a \$300 subsidy to vans on a first come, first served basis, through vRide. The van must originate, terminate or travel through Yuma County to be eligible for the subsidy. HolidayCAT

Each December, YCAT offers a tour of holiday lights around Yuma for one hour. Buses depart from Downtown Yuma Transit Center at 7:00 PM. Normal fares apply. Call YCAT for details or visit our website.

Rules Of The Road

Please observe the following rules when riding YCAT buses or waiting at a YCAT stop, transit center or office:

- No smoking on buses, inside transit facilities or within 20 feet of the opening of a window or door at transit facilities per A.R.S. 36-601.01.
- Eating and drinking is permitted provided that you dispose of the waste from eating or drinking.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted on public transit vehicles under Federal law.
- No standing in front of the white or yellow “standee” line, in doorways or stepwells while the bus is in motion.
- If you are sitting in one of the front seats, be prepared to give up your seat as a courtesy to seniors and persons with disabilities.
- No unnecessary conversation or interference with bus operator for safety reasons.
- No fighting, using vulgar or offensive language, pushing, shouting, or any behavior that disturbs or endangers other passengers.
- All audio devices require the use of headphones. Amplified music is not allowed on buses or at transit facilities.
- No flammable, hazardous materials or weapons shall be allowed on board the bus (except oxygen).
- No large object that cannot be held by the passenger or placed under seat. Passengers are allowed up to five shopping bags, luggage or packages.
- Passengers must have a destination when riding YCAT buses. After two round trips, passengers may be requested to leave the bus by the Bus Operator at the nearest transit center or major transfer point.

- A person who commits an assault or battery upon a transit operator with a deadly weapon or presents the ability to use a deadly weapon is subject to a class 6 felony per A.R.S. 13-1204.
- YCIPTA or its transit operations contractor reserve the right to refuse service to passengers and/or suspend passengers who demonstrate disruptive and unsafe behavior or violate any of the rules and regulations presented above.

Cómo viajar con YCAT

Paradas: Los autobuses de YCAT solo se detienen en las paradas de autobús señalizadas. No se permiten paradas a pedido. Hay una lista completa de las paradas de autobús de cada ruta en nuestro sitio web en www.ycat.az.gov o tome una guía de paradas en el autobús.



Cómo tomar el autobús: Esté en la parada 5 minutos antes de la hora de salida programada. Asegúrese de que el conductor lo vea. Mire el cartel del frente del autobús para asegurarse de tomar la ruta correcta.

Cómo pagar la tarifa: Esté listo para pagar su tarifa o presentar su pase al abordar. Solo se admite el importe exacto. Los conductores de los autobuses no pueden dar cambio.

Cómo salir el autobús: Cuando vea su destino o punto de trasbordo, avísele al conductor del autobús tirando de la cuerda que se encuentra cerca de la ventanilla, presionando la cinta amarilla o avisando que baja en la siguiente parada (“next stop”). Avise con suficiente anticipación para que el conductor pueda detenerse de manera segura. Si no está familiarizado con la zona, pídale ayuda al conductor del autobús.

Desviaciones de ruta flexible: En algunas rutas, usted puede solicitar que lo recojan o lo dejen en lugares situados entre las paradas habitualmente programadas. Las desviaciones son posibles:

- En cualquier lugar a lo largo de la Ruta 3 marrón dentro de Fortuna Foothills.
- En la Ruta 5 azul dentro de la Reserva indígena de Fort Yuma y en un radio de 3/4 milla de la ruta real.
- Dentro de las Reservas Cocopah en la Ruta 6/6A violeta.
- En la Ruta 8 dorada dentro de un radio de 1 y 1/2 milla de la ruta real.

Simplemente hable con el conductor para que lo deje en uno de los puntos de desviación. Para que lo recojan, llame al (928) 783-2235 al menos una hora antes de que pase el autobús por su ubicación y solicite una desviación. Las desviaciones se limitan a las primeras cuatro (4) solicitudes por viaje de ida. Llame con anticipación si ya no necesita la desviación para que otra persona aproveche la oportunidad para viajar.

Night Owl: Durante la noche, a pedido, el conductor del autobús puede parar en el lugar más cercano a su destino final, en lugar de hacerlo en la parada habitual. El conductor del autobús determinará dónde es seguro detenerse.

Bicicletas: Hay soportes para bicicletas en la parte delantera de todos los autobuses YCAT. Los soportes están disponibles por orden de llegada. Los pasajeros tienen la responsabilidad de cargar y descargar las bicicletas, y el uso de los soportes corre por su cuenta y riesgo. Infórmele al conductor cuando tenga que cargar o descargar una bicicleta.



Animales en YCAT: Se aceptan animales de servicio. Los animales que no son de servicio pueden viajar en los autobuses siempre que estén dentro de una jaula o tengan bozal.

Objetos perdidos: Si olvida un artículo en un vehículo de YCAT, llame al (928) 783-2235 para ver si ha sido recuperado. Ni YCIPTA ni sus contratistas se responsabilizan por la pérdida o el robo de objetos a bordo de sus vehículos.

Servicios especiales para personas con discapacidades y adultos mayores

Servicio previo pedido YCAT OnCall

Este servicio de puerta a puerta previo pedido está disponible para personas que no pueden abordar los autobuses de YCAT o que no pueden llegar a la parada del autobús. Para usar YCAT OnCall, los pasajeros deben completar una solicitud de certificación conforme a la Ley de Estadounidenses con Discapacidades (ADA). YCAT OnCall opera en los mismos horarios de servicio que el servicio no express de ruta fija de YCAT. Los pasajeros deben abordar, viajar y descender dentro de un área de 3/4 milla de una ruta operada por YCAT. Para conocer los límites del servicio YCAT OnCall, consulte el mapa del sistema. Accesibilidad

Todos los vehículos de YCAT están completamente equipados con ascensores de dispositivos de movilidad y área de fijación de dichos dispositivos, con espacio para entre dos y cuatro dispositivos de movilidad. El conductor del autobús ayudará con el abordaje o el descenso normal, la



fijación del dispositivo de movilidad y el funcionamiento del ascensor o la rampa. Los conductores de los autobuses YCAT tienen la obligación de asegurar todos los dispositivos de movilidad antes de que el autobús salga de la parada.

A los pasajeros que usen scooter se les podrá pedir que se pasen a un asiento del autobús. Todos los equipos de movilidad deben caber en el espacio asignado, tener frenos que funcionen y no pueden superar la capacidad del ascensor o la rampa (con el pasajero). Si llega a su parada un autobús de YCAT sin ascensor en funcionamiento para sillas de ruedas, YCAT enviará un supervisor de carretera o un autobús YCAT OnCall en un máximo de 30 minutos para llevar al pasajero directamente a su destino sin cargo.

Asistentes de cuidados personales

Un asistente de cuidados personales puede acompañar a una persona con una discapacidad sin cargo adicional. Si necesita un asistente de cuidados personales, llame al (928) 783-2235 con un día de anticipación. La tarifa es de \$10.00 por hora.

Transporte compartido de YCAT

Compartir el transporte es una excelente opción para grupos más grandes de pasajeros. El transporte compartido de YCAT ofrece furgonetas claramente identificadas para grupos de 7 a 15 pasajeros que cumplan los requisitos. El conductor es una de las personas que comparten el transporte. Los pasajeros comparten el costo de viajar en la furgoneta y le pagan un cargo mensual al conductor principal. El cargo cubre los costos de gasolina, seguro y mantenimiento del vehículo. YCIPTA ofrece un subsidio de \$300 a furgonetas, disponible por orden de llegada, a través de

Reglas de la carretera

Cumpla con las siguientes reglas cuando viaje en los autobuses de YCAT o espere en una parada de YCAT, una oficina o un centro de transporte público:

- No se permite fumar en los autobuses, dentro de los centros de transporte público ni a menos de 20 pies de la abertura de una ventana o puerta en los centros de transporte público de conformidad con A.R.S. 36-601.01.
- Comer y beber está permitido siempre y cuando usted deseche los residuos de lo que coma o beba.
- De acuerdo con la legislación federal, está prohibido consumir bebidas alcohólicas en los vehículos de transporte público.
- Mientras el autobús está en movimiento, está prohibido pararse delante de la línea blanca o amarilla que limita el espacio donde puede haber pasajeros de pie, en el paso a las puertas o en los huecos de los escalones.
- Si está sentado en uno de los asientos delanteros, prepárese para cedérselo como cortesía a los adultos mayores y las personas con discapacidades.
- Por motivos de seguridad, evite conversar con el conductor del autobús o distraerlo.

- Se prohíbe pelear, usar lenguaje vulgar u ofensivo, empujar, gritar o tener cualquier tipo de comportamiento que perturbe o ponga en peligro a otros pasajeros.
- Todos los dispositivos de audio requieren el uso de auriculares. No se permite la música amplificada en los autobuses ni en los centros de transporte público.
- No se permiten materiales inflamables ni peligrosos, así como tampoco armas, a bordo del autobús (salvo oxígeno).
- No se permiten objetos grandes que no puedan ser sostenidos por el pasajero o colocados debajo del asiento. Los pasajeros tienen permitido un máximo de cinco bolsas de compras, bultos de equipaje o paquetes.
- Los pasajeros que viajen en los autobuses YCAT deben tener un destino. Después de dos recorridos completos, el conductor puede pedirles a los pasajeros que se bajen del autobús en el centro de transporte público o punto de trasbordo más cercano.
- Si una persona asalta o agrede a un conductor de transporte público con un arma mortal o amenaza con usar un arma mortal, estará cometiendo un delito grave de clase 6, de acuerdo con A.R.S. 13-1204.
- YCIPTA o sus contratistas de operaciones de transporte público se reservan el derecho de negarles el servicio a pasajeros o expulsar temporalmente a pasajeros que demuestren un comportamiento perturbador o poco seguro o que infrinja cualquiera de las reglas y reglamentos indicados arriba.
- YCIPTA o sus contratistas de operaciones de transporte público se reservan el derecho de negarles el servicio a pasajeros o expulsar temporalmente a pasajeros que demuestren un comportamiento perturbador o poco seguro o que infrinja cualquiera de las reglas y reglamentos indicados arriba.
